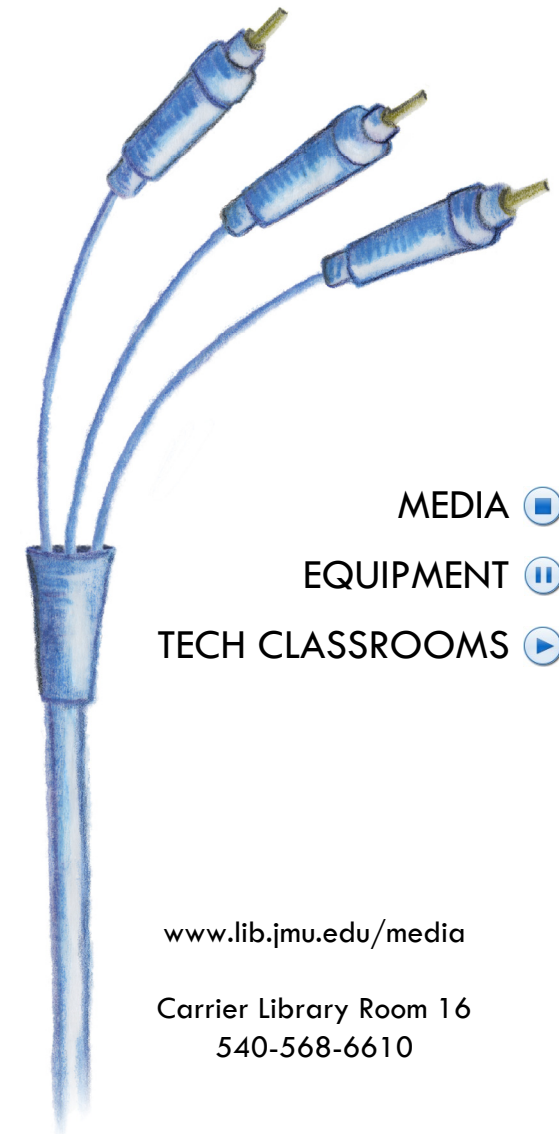

The media center houses a collection of commercial media in a variety of formats that can be used in the center, in classrooms and in other locations. The center has individual and group viewing carrels and a 30-seat technology classroom (TC) available for occasional classroom use or for student practice of presentation skills. The TC contains the newest technology including a user friendly control system, Blu-ray player, surround sound, and 16:9 projector. To schedule the TC, contact media center staff.
